Aboriginal artist, Bernadine Johnson paints mesmerizing artworks depicting the hundreds of gathered medicine leaves drying in the sun before being used for traditional medicine.

These paintings are inspired by tens-of-thousands of years of traditional medicine preparation and usage by the Central and Western Desert Aboriginal peoples.

Bernadine's paintings contain a pulsating rhythm, characteristic of the bush medicine leaf style. In between each painted stroke, the artist inserts tiny white painted dots to indicate the medicine seeds of the plant. Bernadine's fluid paintings add a relaxing ambience to any room.
