Muroka is a less common class of Junmai Daiginjo that is unfiltered and undiluted which imparts a rich and full-bodied rice aroma and delivers a natural sake taste. Not to be confused with Nigori which is cloudy sake that is roughly filtered, Muroka is clear sake that has not been refined to remove color or watered down.

Rare as a shooting star, the Ryusei Junmai Daiginjo Muroka titillates the senses and uplifts the spirit like a meteor illuminating the blank canvas of a sky, with a delicate balance of sake freshness and aroma richness harmonized by the natural plump flavor of precious rice.

Dry with a rich umami taste.
